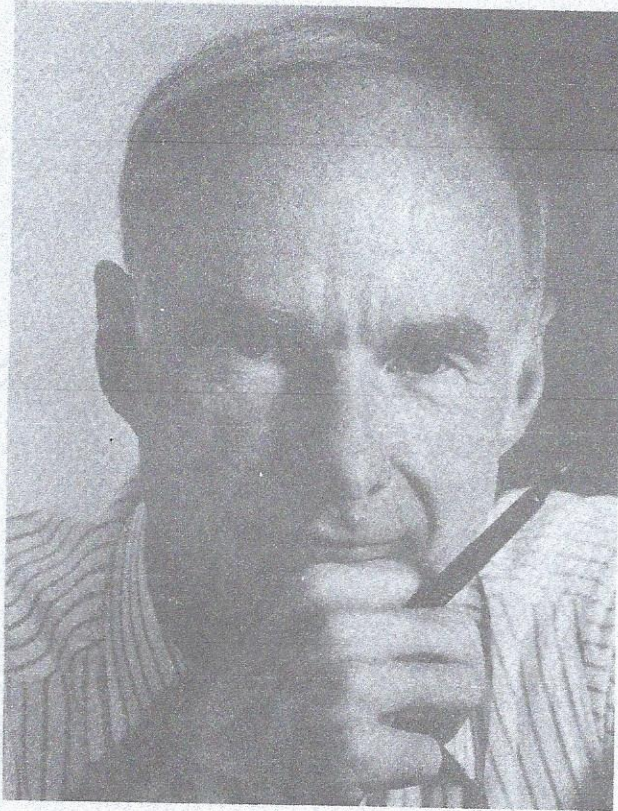

The glory of Israel has been taken from us, how are the mighty fallen (II Samuel 1:19).

In every generation, God lifts up special people, divine emissaries, calling them to a sacred task. Jamie was such a person.

O' Jamie, my brother, how are the mighty fallen? You were, for me and countless others, a shining manifestation of God's presence on this earth. Yes, you were brilliant, incisive and supremely honest - indeed, a man of incredible integrity; yes, you were a wonderful writer, pastor and teacher; yes, you had an uncanny ability to look right through events and people, to excoriate falsehood, highlight hypocrisy and re-direct our course when we deviated from the path. You had so many wonderful traits and virtues.

But Jamie, you were so much more...you embodies God's love.

Through your presence among us, you shared that love with us all. You gave us a glimpse into the realm of the divine. And, Jamie, more than anything else, it is that quality of love that you lived that sets you apart as such a special man of God.
