**PALM BAY** — The Rev. Jamie Buckingham, 59, founder and pastor of Tabernacle Church in Melbourne, died Monday, Feb. 17, at Holmes Regional Medical Center in Melbourne.

A Florida native, Rev. Buckingham was born in Vero Beach and came to Brevard County in 1965 from Greenwood, S.C.

He was the editor of *Ministry Today* magazine, a columnist with *Charisma* magazine, and authored more than 42 books.

Survivors include his wife, Jackie Buckingham of Palm Bay; sons, Bruce Buckingham and Tim Buckingham, both of Palm Bay; daughters, Robin Moore and Sandy Smith, both of Palm Bay and Bonnie Ranzino of West Melbourne; mother, Elvira Buckingham of Vero Beach; brothers, retired Major General Clay Buckingham of Manns Choice, Pa., and John Buckingham of Birmingham, Ala.; sister, Audrey Unruh of Missouri; and 13 grandchildren.
